



On-site sewage treatment systems (septic systems) can contribute to groundwater contamination if they are not operated properly or if not maintained on a regular schedule.

- **You can help by making sure your system is compliant with local regulations.**
- **Have your system pumped and inspected every 2-3 years.**
- **Prevent paint or other hazardous materials from entering the system.**
- **Don't use harsh household chemicals or additives.**
- **Use liquid soaps for washing dishes and clothes.**
