



The City is working cooperatively with homeowners to implement stormwater Best Management Practices to help protect drinking water supplies.

STEPS YOU CAN TAKE TO PROTECT YOUR DRINKING WATER

- Properly dispose of household products such as insecticides, pesticides, paint, etc... Don't pour them onto the ground or into storm drains.
- Don't over water your lawn.
- Use pesticides and fertilizers sparingly. When necessary, use these chemicals in the recommended amounts and always sweep off sidewalks and driveways.
- Compost or mulch yard waste. Don't leave it in the street or sweep it into storm drains or streams.
- Remember to pick up all pet waste and dispose of it properly.
- Use a commercial car wash that treats or recycles its wastewater, or wash your car on your yard so the water infiltrates into the ground.
- Repair leaks and dispose of used auto fluids and batteries at designated drop-off or recycling locations.
