


SEPTEMBER CLASSES

Beginning Knitting: Tues. Sept. 3, 1-4



This class is designed for the beginner. Anyone wanting to learn (or re-learn) the basics of knitting is welcome to join this class. Students will receive a set of straight needles, a skein of yarn and handouts. We will learn a basic cast on, bind off, knit stitch and purl stitch. Cost: \$35

Beginning Crochet: Tues. Sept 10, 1-4



This class is designed for the beginner. Anyone wanting to learn (or re-learn) the basics of crochet is welcome to join this class. Students will receive a crochet hook, skein of yarn and handouts. We will learn to chain stitch, single, double and half double crochet. Cost: \$35.

Beginning Small Loom Weaving: Thurs. Sept. 12, 19, and 26. 1-4



Learn to weave. This class will focus on different weaving technique that you can use to create your own unique woven projects. We will learn the basic weave and then how to embellish it with more advanced weaving techniques. All supplies will be provided. We will be using a small loom and a weaving needle that you will take with you. You will learn to make your own loom any size you need to accommodate your next project. If you have any sticks, shells, beads, etc. that you wish to incorporate into your weaving, bring them to class. This class will meet for 3 -3 hr. sessions. The price covers all sessions. Cost of this class is \$45.

Basic Needle Felting: Tues. Sept 17, 1-4



Come and make a snowman! Perfect for a gift or to sit or to keep. In this class we will learn the basics of needle felting. We will discuss the qualities of wool that make it possible. We will look at the tools used and learn basic sculpting techniques. Each student will take home a set of three felting needles, a foam felting board and a finished project. All Supplies are included in the class price. Cost: \$45.

Improve Your Knitting Skills: Advanced Knitting Class



Perfect for cold weather wearing or gift giving. These warm slippers are knit using two strands of worsted weight yarn or one strand of bulky. They knit up quickly on size 10 needles. They are knit flat and seamed. Pattern is free to students. No other supplies are provided but may be purchased at Arachne Yarns and More or elsewhere. Come and knit with others. Enjoy some coffee and conversation and knit up these warm, quick slippers. Cost for class is \$10 and includes all Wednesdays in September from 1-4.

Please remember that you must pre-register for classes. This ensures that materials are available and helps to manage class size. Hope to see you!
