The City of Ortonville, MN, in west central Minnesota, is accepting applications for an immediate opening for the position of a full-time Police Officer and to establish an eligibility list for future openings. Full time police officer application deadline is Friday, April 1, 2022. Eligibility list for future openings will be ongoing.

We welcome both entry-level and experienced lateral candidates. Out-of-state officers/former military encouraged to apply, provided reciprocal licensing process through the MN Post Board is met. General duties of the position are to perform responsible police work involving the protection and safety of the community through prevention and control of crime, preserving peace, regulating traffic, providing emergency services, and other related duties as required.

Applicants must have an AAS degree or higher and must possess a MN POST Board Police Officer License or must be eligible to be licensed by the time of appointment, possess a valid MN driver's license, and pass a background investigation, employment physical, and psychological exam.

Excellent pay with shift differential, on-call pay, overtime opportunities, vacation, sick leave and comp time. Uniforms, duty gear, and equipment provided by department, PERA retirement, life insurance, vision, dental, health and \$1,000 per month miscellaneous benefit.
